

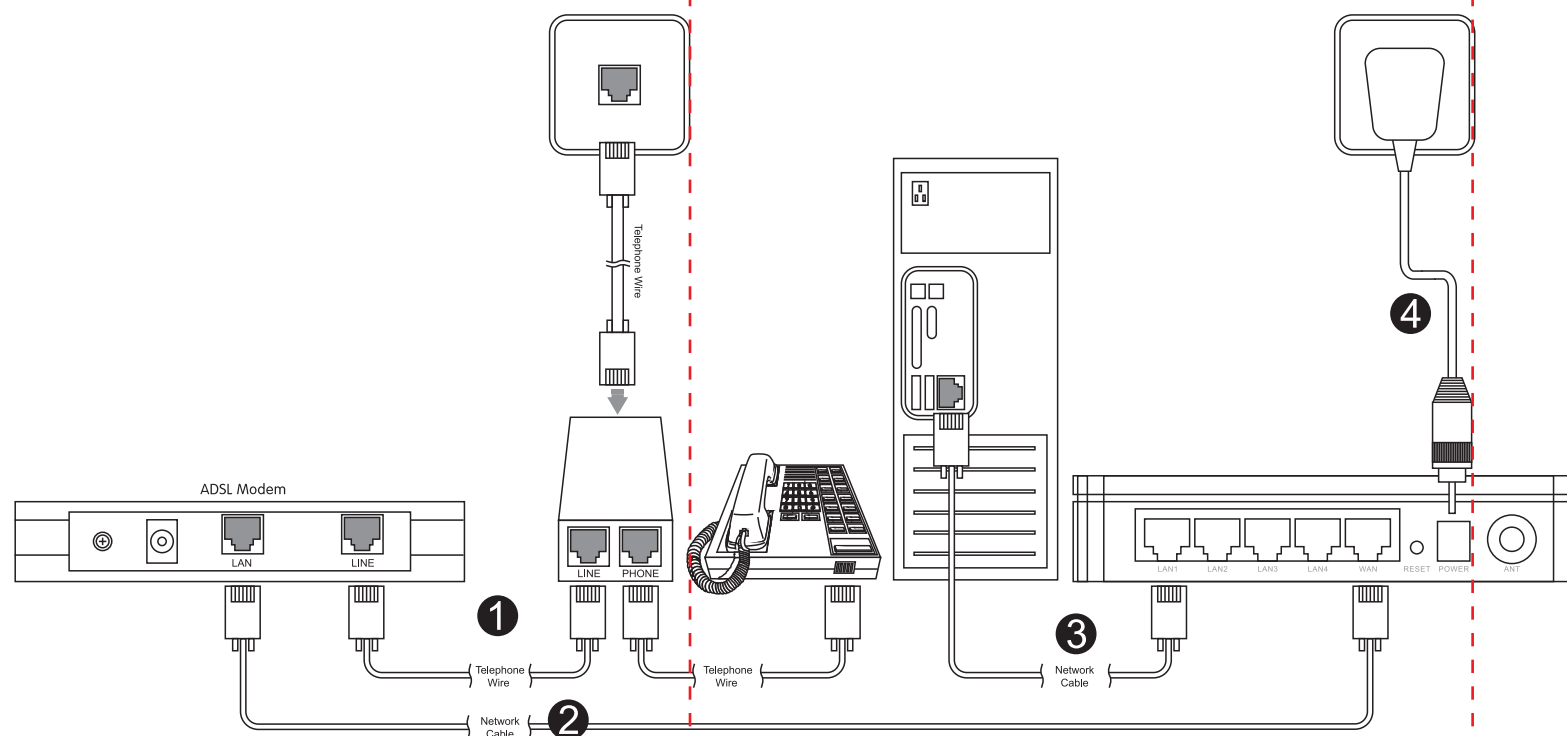
Quick Installation Guide

Wireless-N Broadband Router

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1 Hardware Installation

If you access Internet by ADSL, please comply with step 1, 2, 3 and 4 in below diagram in correct order; if you access Internet by residential broadband, please comply with step 2, 3 and 4 to connect the WAN port of your router with the residential broadband directly.



After connected, please check whether the indicator lights are normal.

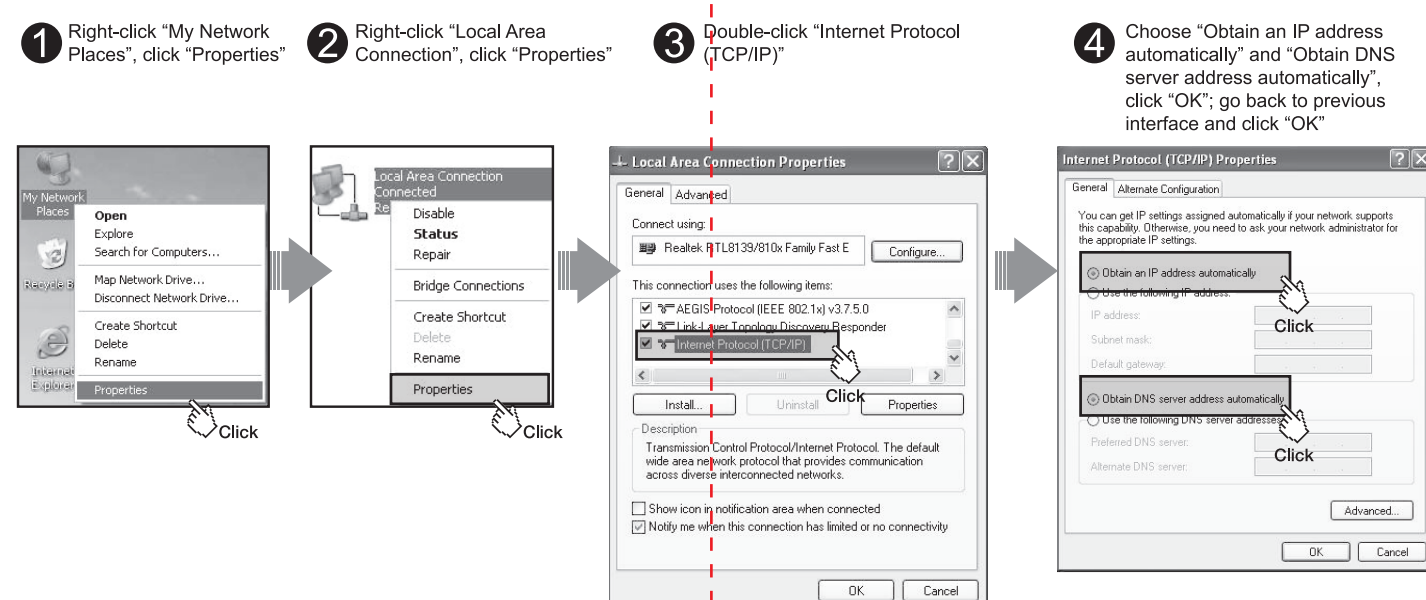
Name	Normal Status
Power	Lights blue when the router is switched on
CPU	Blinks blue
WLAN	Lights blue while transmitting data
WAN	Lights or blinks blue
LAN	Lights or blinks blue

NOTE:

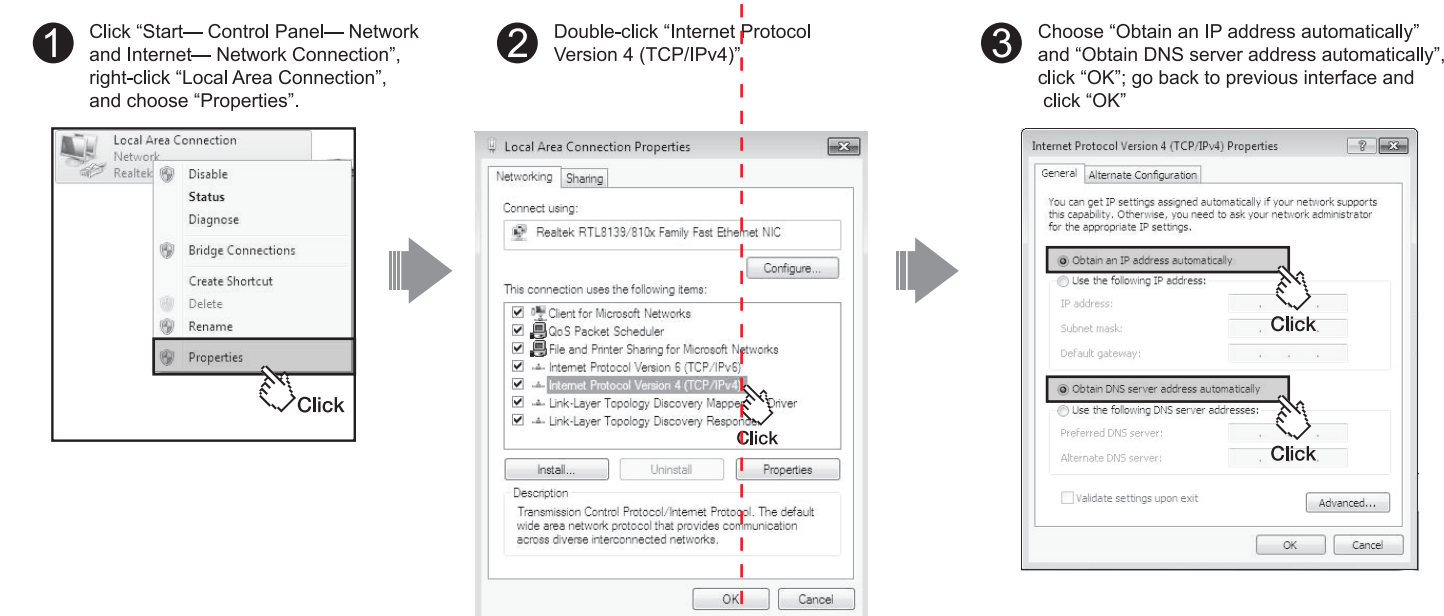
1. Please disconnect the power adapter and all cables during thunderstorm weather;
2. Keep away from heat source and keep well ventilated;
3. Please pay attention to the waterproofing and moisture-proof when storing, transporting and running.
4. The power supply must reach the rated current and power.
5. Put the router in flat places.

Windows 2000/XP For Windows 2000 or Windows XP Operating System, please comply with following steps to set up.

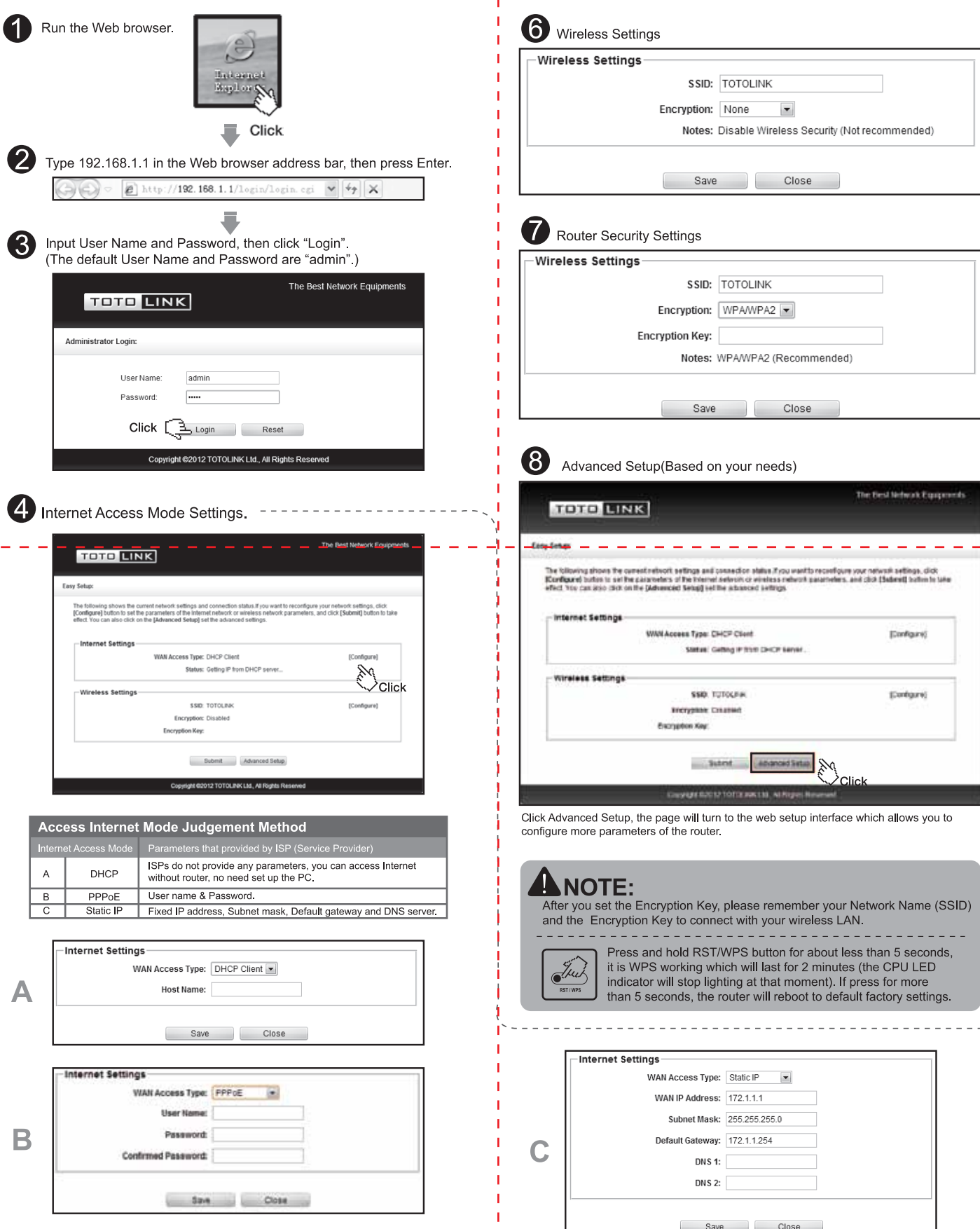


Windows Vista/7 For Windows Vista or Windows 7 Operating System, please comply with following steps to set up.
